WHEREAS, Active in religious and civic organizations, he was Past President of Temple Emanuel and a Member of its Board for more than one-half a century, an Honorary President of the Temple at the time of his death, a Board Member of Miriam Hospital, the Jewish Federation of Rhode Island, the Jewish Home for the Aged, the Jewish Family and Childrens Service and the Jewish Community Center, and

WHEREAS, He was the recipient of Honorary Degrees and Citations from various organizations, Mr. Rosen being an impressive and exemplary citizen, and

WHEREAS, He was the Founder of E. Rosen Candy Company in 1912, which is now a major manufacturer of candy and candy novelties in this Country,
