No. 355 **AN ORDINANCE** for the Establishment of the Authorization of the Dog Officer and his agents to serve summonses and/or citations.

Approved June 8, 1977

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

Section 1. 4-49.1 is hereby added to the Ordinances of the City of Providence and reads as follows:

Section 4-49.1. The Dog Officer and his duly qualified agents shall hereby have the authority to serve summonses and/or citations for appearance before the Municipal Court of Providence for violation of those sections of the Providence Code of Ordinances pertaining to dogs; to wit: Section 4 entitled "Animals and Dogs."

Section 2. The above authority shall extend to any police officer of said City.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage by the City Council and approved by the Mayor.
