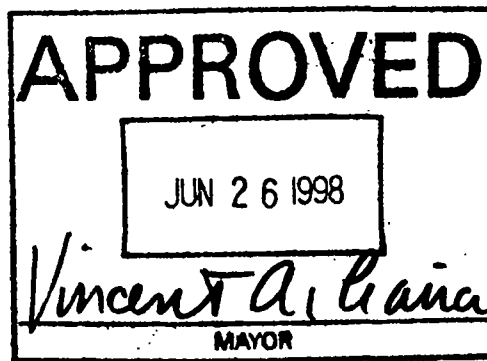
Benevolent Street one-way west travel from Brown to Magee Streets.
