Dear Councilman Lombardi:

Rebuilding Together with Christmas in April Providence respectfully requests your support in waiving the fees we currently pay in order to rehabilitate disabled, elderly, and family resident's homes in Providence. While all of the permit departments in the city have been very supportive of our program, we hope to eliminate this cost from our annual budget.

On April 28, 2001 Rebuilding Together Providence volunteers rehabilitated 36 properties in 13 neighborhoods of Providence. Over 2,100 volunteers from skilled trades organizations, the I.B.E.W. Local 99, corporate sponsors, colleges and healthcare institutions made it all possible. In eight years, we have worked with 212 property owners and non-profit organizations. All work completed is done free of charge and all building materials are donated or purchased with donor funds.

We hope that you will seriously consider this important request. Currently, plans are underway for property rehabilitation on April 27, 2002. We would like to formally request approximately 33 site fee waivers for electrical, plumbing, roofing, and carpentry projects.
