Department of Commerce, United States of America,) an application for Federal Grant for Sewage Treatment Works to aid in financing the construction of the same to be submitted in triplicate to the Water Pollution Control Agency of the State of Rhode Island, said application for Federal assistance as above indicated being for the following project which includes three items, as follows:

1. Construct 18" Vitrified Pipe Sewers including Sluice Gates at Ernest Street.
2. Furnish and Install 2-30 HP Variable Speed Sewage Pumps and Controls.
3. Furnish and Install Chlorinizer and Vaporizer at Sewage Treatment Plant.

All of the above in the City of Providence; and the City Council of the City of Providence agrees that if a Federal Grant for the project is made pursuant to Federal Law, under the Public Works and ^{xx}(Economic Development Act of 1965 Public Law 89-136,) the same to be submitted to the ^{xxx}(Economic Development Administration U. S. Department of Commerce,) said application for Federal assistance as indicated that the applicant City of Providence will pay the remaining cost of the approved project, and the City of Providence will provide proper and efficient operation and maintenance of these items of the approved project after completion of the installation thereof.

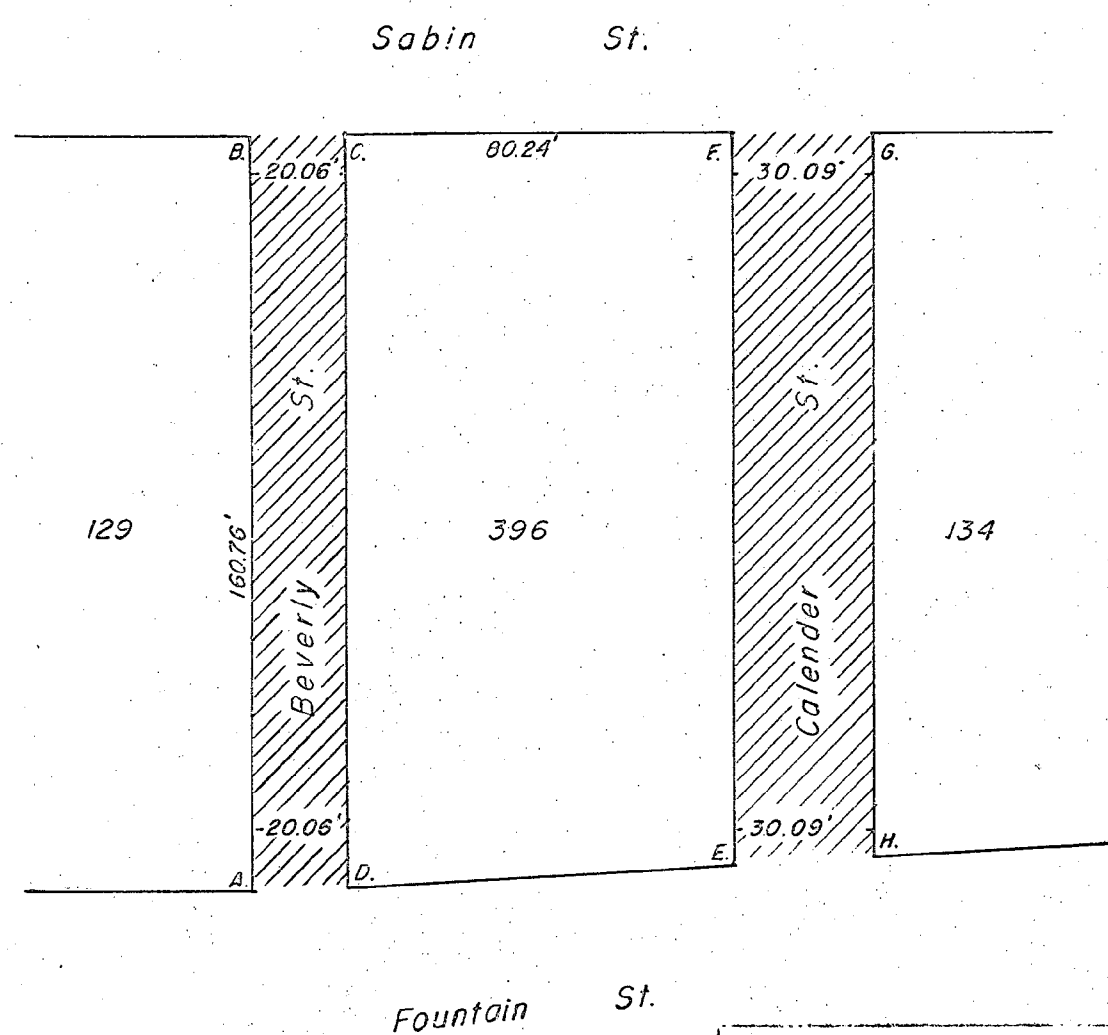
