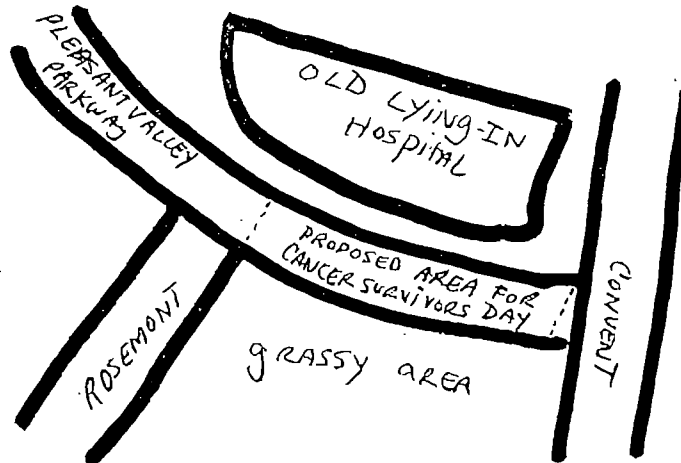


Beth,

I spoke with Doreen Picozzi last week and she recommended I send you a fax with the details about what we're doing for National Cancer Survivors Day.

The date of the event is June 1, 2002. It should run from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. For setup and breakdown purposes, we would like the area from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. The event will include speakers, booths, and food.

What we're hoping to do is to cordon off the end of Pleasant Valley Parkway to use for the event. It is the end of the Parkway behind the old Lying-In Hospital, a building that is now medical offices and a nursing home owned by the hospital. The two streets at the end of the cordoned-off area are Rosebank and Convent.



This is a low traffic area that is essentially used as a short cut for most people.

When you drive down this road – on the opposite side from the nursing home – there is a small patch of grass. We would like to use that as well.

The hospital can create signage to let people know there is an event so they won't cut through. What we need is authorization from the city to do so and whatever else you tell me is necessary! Please call me at 456-2421 and tell me what the next step is. Thanks!
