Approved March 9, 1973

WHEREAS, a dire need for low cost housing for the elderly exists in the Potters Avenue-Elmwood Avenue sections of the City of Providence, Rhode Island, and

WHEREAS, the above designated areas have a number of elderly people who, by enlarge, are just on incomes from Social Security or other retirement income, and

WHEREAS, these Senior Citizens are forced to live, oftentimes, in substandard housing while paying exorbitant rents,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Providence recognize this need for low cost housing for its Senior Citizens in this designated area, go on record as being in favor of public or private development of housing to alleviate this acute situation.
