RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 40

Approved January 28, 1977

WHEREAS, numerous complaints have been called to the attention of Council President Pro Tempore Ralph Fagnoli, sponsor of this Resolution, regarding the ineffectual removal of snow from certain City Streets, this winter season, which has caused much chagrin, and

WHEREAS, a public announcement, by His Honor the Mayor, reported that approximately Three Hundred Sixty-Five Thousand (\$365,000.00) Dollars, had been expended for City Snow Removal, this same season,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Director of Public Works is requested to report, in writing, to the City Council, the following:

1. Total Expenditures for Snow Removal;
2. Names and Addresses of Trucking Firms engaged in the Removal and Amount Paid to Each Firm;
3. Amount of the Overtime paid to Employees, in the Highway Department for the Snow Removal, and
4. Total Cost of Salt and Sand Utilized for same.
