# State of Rhode Island, &c.

## IN GENERAL ASSEMBLY

JANUARY SESSION, A. D. 1979

### AN ACT

Providing for Exemption from State and Local Taxes for the Property Owned by the Foundation for Repertory Theatre of Rhode Island, Inc.

*It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:*

Section 1. That the building known as the Lederer Theatre and located at 201 Washington Street, Providence, Rhode Island, now owned by the Foundation for Repertory Theatre of Rhode Island, Inc., together with the land upon which said building is located and any personal property owned by the said Foundation and used in connection with its functions shall be exempt from any and all taxes imposed, assessed, levied or collected by the State of Rhode Island or the City of Providence or any agency thereof, provided that said real and personal property shall be exempt from said taxes only so long as the same shall be owned by the said Foundation.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
