RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 233

Approved April 13, 1984

WHEREAS, On Monday, March 12, 1984, Providence Police responded to a house on Ida Street and found a young man with a semiautomatic 22 caliber rifle pointed at his head, threatening to commit suicide if police came near him, and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Robert T. Kells talked to the man for more than one hour before finally convincing him to abandon his suicide attempt and surrender his rifle, and

WHEREAS, The young man now is undergoing treatment, and has the opportunity to live a long and fruitful life, thanks to Sergeant Kells and the other officers involved, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the City Council does commend Sergeant Kells for his brave actions in saving the life of this young man, on March 12, 1984, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City Clerk is directed to cause duly engrossed copies of this Resolution to be transmitted to Sergeant Kells and to Colonel Anthony Mancuso, to convey the admiration of the City Council and its congratulations for a job well done.
