WHEREAS, Mr. Ford was a Past President of the Urban League of Rhode Island, a Member of the Mayor's Committee on Housing and Relocation in Providence and a Member of the Board of Bannister House, and

WHEREAS, He received the Urban League of Rhode Island Award for outstanding community service in 1983 and the Providence Branch NAACP Outstanding Service Award in 1982, The Bronze Brotherhood Award of the National Conference of Christians and Jews was posthumously awarded to him on May 3, 1984,
