RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 672

Approved December 12, 1985

RESOLVED, that the City Solicitor be and he hereby is authorized and directed to apply to the General Assembly for the passage of an Act in amendment of the Act relating to sewer assessment within the City of Providence, to provide that such assessment shall be made "to the abutting property owners on a basis of 75% of the total cost of installing said sewers taking into consideration the following factors: cost of material, labor, mechanical equipment, engineering design and inspection costs (at time of installation); excepting any lots that have been previously assessed for sanitary sewer use," in lieu of the present assessment of the rate of \$.60 for each front foot of such estate upon such street or highway, and \$.02 for each square foot of such estates between such street or highway and a line not exceeding 150 feet distant from and parallel with the line of such street or highway.


