SECTION 1. Chapter 1644 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence as approved September 23, 1964 entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$46,159,931.36 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1965", as amended, is hereby further amended by appropriating the sum of Five Thousand Five Hundred Fifty Six (\$5,556) Dollars to FIRE DEPARTMENT, ITEM 0.

SECTION 2. The said sum of Five Thousand Five Hundred Fifty Six: (\$5,556) Dollars as thus added and appropriated shall be charged to the General Fund from Funds Not Otherwise Appropriated.







PERSONNEL AIDE - - FIRE DEPARTMENT

CLASS TITLE: Personnel Aide-Fire Department

CLASS DEFINITION: Aid and assist the Chief of Department in personnel, administrative, and operational matters concerning the Fire Department.

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES AND ILLUSTRATIVE EXAMPLES OF WORK:

1. Investigate, inspect, report and record, and administer various personnel and operational aspects of the Fire Department resulting from the application of the Rules and Regulations of the Department and the Union Contract.
2. Examine personnel reports and records required and submitted within the Department in order that recommendations can be made that are fair and just to the City and to personnel involved, to wit: sections of the Union Contract such as clothing replacement, injury, sickness and its allied categories, overtime work, recall to duty, and acting out of rank.
3. Assist the Chief of Department in his administration of the Fire Department by various recommendations concerning personnel matters.
4. Aid the Chief of Department in the deployment of personnel at the scene of multiple alarm fires and other emergencies. Also assist the Chief of Department in the coordination of operations at the scene of such fires or emergencies.
5. Instruct officers and prospective officers of the Department in administrative details of the Department such as reports, records, filing, new administrative procedures concerning the Department, or any other subject which the Chief of Department may require or direct.

DESIRABLE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS & ABILITIES:

1. Must have a complete and thorough knowledge of the organization and operations of the Fire Department; of the rules, regulations, orders, and policies governing the Fire Department; and of the Union Contract.
2. Must be capable of making recommendations that are fair to the parties concerned.
3. Must have initiative, resourcefulness and good judgment.
4. Must have the ability to express oneself clearly and concisely, orally and in writing.

1. Should have at least two years of college, preferably a college graduate.
2. Experience in the military service in a supervisory capacity would be desirable.
3. Should have a knowledge of staff functioning.


