
Gentlemen:

The Traffic Engineering Department has received the following resolution from your Committee and has taken the subsequent action:

Request: That the Traffic Engineer is requested to post "One Hour Parking 8AM to 6PM" signs along both sides of Enfield Avenue from Eaton Street for a distance of fifty feet.

Disposition: Since there is a blanket regulation prohibiting parking within 25 feet of any corner, I do not feel that it would be worthwhile to post a sign that would regulate parking for two or three vehicles. We generally post this type of regulation for an entire block or even the entire length of a street. I will have posted the City Ordinance prohibiting parking for 25 feet and see if this eliminates the problem.
