RESOLVED, That the City Treasurer, acting under the direction of the Committee on Finance, be, and he hereby is authorized and directed to borrow from time to time such sums as may be necessary, not exceeding THREE MILLION (\$3,000,000) DOLLARS, in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 18 of the Public Laws, passed by the General Assembly at its January Session, A.D. 1966, and approved February 25, 1966, entitled "An Act Authorizing the City of Providence to Issue Bonds in the Amount of THREE MILLION (\$3,000,000) DOLLARS for the Modernization, Construction and Acquisition of Land for School Purposes", and to issue the City's notes therefor, signed by him and countersigned by the Mayor and Chairman of Finance Committee; and to renew any such notes from time to time as the same become due. The money thus obtained is hereby appropriated for and shall be expended for the modernization and construction of schools in the City of Providence, including the purchase or condemnation of land for such purposes.
