Approved April 24, 1986

WHEREAS, In 1950, the Rhode Island General Assembly designated the last Friday in April as Arbor Day and called upon teachers and school officials to annually commemorate the planting, conservation and beauty of trees, and

WHEREAS, Throughout our City, the trees in our urban forest provide a special aesthetic beauty and enhance the quality of life here in our City,

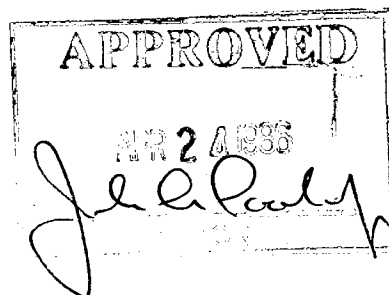
