the following named person, firm or corporation is hereby granted permission to erect, alter or use a building or structure at the location named herein for the sale of petroleum, kerosene, gasoline, coal oil and their products, compounds and components as described and shown in and on the application therefor and accompanying plat, all on file in the office of the Department of Building Inspection subject to the conditions that said person, firm or corporation shall not violate any of the laws of the State of Rhode Island or any of the Ordinances of the City of Providence relative to the erection, use or occupation of said structure and that said person, firm or corporation shall not allow petroleum, kerosene, gasoline, coal oil or their products, compounds or components, to be conveyed over or across any sidewalk by means of any pipe or hose, and upon such special conditions as are hereby enumerated and further provided that the Director of the Department of Building Inspection may authorize minor changes in the structural detail of plans on file, viz:

Mario Gabriele, 400 -406 Silver Spring Street, Plat 77, Lot 207, one (1) 6,000 gallon tank and two (2) dual pumps and one (1) single pump making a total of 10,000 gallons capacity and five (5) filling pumps.

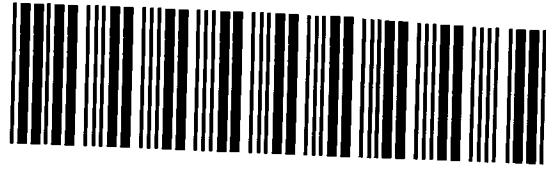

Dear Sir & Madam:

At a meeting of the Zoning Board of Review held on Tuesday, July 30, 1974, the following resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, Ralph Bianco & wf. Theresa, owners of Lot 20 on Assessor's Plot 60 (724 Elmwood Ave.) in a Commercial C-4 Zone; on July 9, 1974, filed an application for permission to be relieved from Section 54-A-3 of the Zoning Ordinance in the proposed removal of present underground storage tanks and replacing with 2 new 5,000 gallon underground storage tanks on the above described premises, for a total of 10,000 gallons. The lot in question contains approximately 5,000 sq. ft. of land area, and

WHEREAS, on Tuesday, July 30, 1974, the members of the Zoning Board of Review made an inspection of the above described premises and also of the surrounding properties and noted that the property was well maintained, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on this application by the Zoning Board of Review at its meeting held on Tuesday, July 30, 1974, after public notice as provided by the Zoning Ordinance,

RESOLVED: That the Zoning Board of Review does hereby make the variance of Section 54-A-3 under the Zoning Ordinance and does hereby grant the application of Ralph Bianco & wf. Theresa, substantially in accordance with the plans and plot plans filed with said Board, provided a solid evergreen fence be planted along abutting residential properties. A copy of said plans and plot plans are hereby made a part of this resolution and filed with the Director of the Department of Building Inspection.
