ORDERED, That after the entry of this order or decree the City Clerk shall cause a notice thereof to be published in a newspaper published in the County of Providence, at least once each week for three successive weeks and a further and personal notice shall be served by the City Sergeant upon every owner of land abutting upon Gay Street, from Willard Avenue to a point 144.77 feet northerly, which has been abandoned, who is known to reside within this State.

VOTED: To offer no objection is offered to the abandonment of these streets which are in the Willard Center Project.

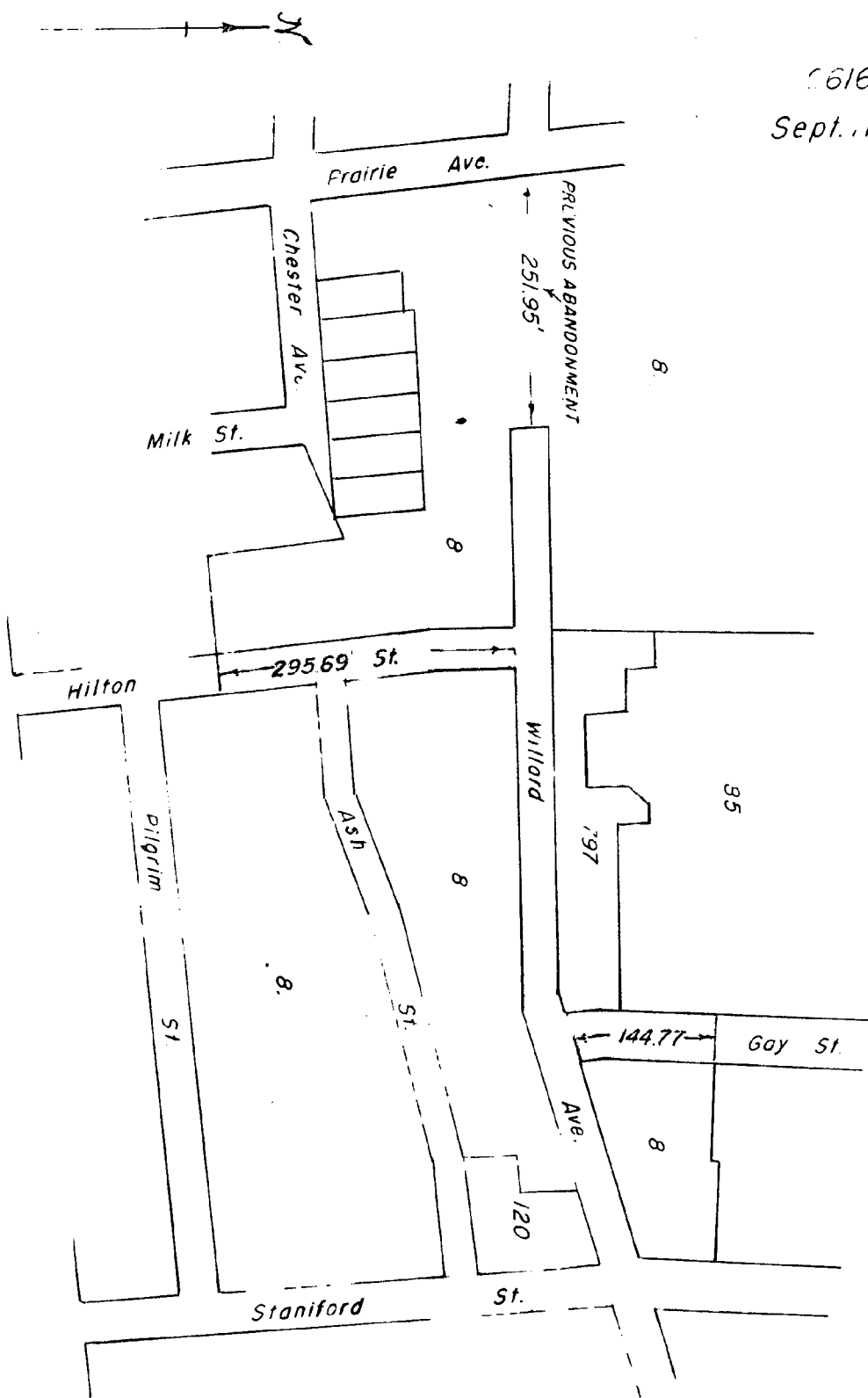
