RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 110

Approved March 26, 1976

WHEREAS, there is presently pending before the Senate Committee on Judiciary, An Act Identified as 76-S, 2362 relating to the Detention of Juveniles, and

WHEREAS, this Act, if passed by the General Assembly and approved by His Excellency, the Governor, would create much fear in residents of and around the Dr. Patrick I. O'Rourke Children Center in Providence, where reports indicate the proposed facility would be located,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that this City Council unequivocally opposes the establishment and maintaining of a Detention Center for Juveniles upon the Dr. Patrick I. O'Rourke Children Center Complex, Providence, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in the event of the passage of the said Act, His Excellency the Governor is respectfully requested to Veto the same.
