I am writing to request that the following requested contract awards be submitted to the City Council and the Finance Committee for approval:

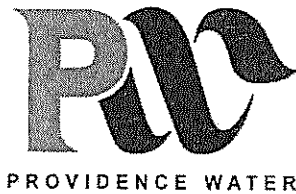
