

# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

RESOLVED, that the Committee on Finance is requested to study the feasibility of exempting Citizens of the City of Providence, who were Prisoners of War of the Vietnam Conflict, from personal property taxes that may be levied upon motor vehicles owned and registered in their name, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon the study, the completion of such recommendation of the said Committee and the adoption by the City Council, the City Solicitor is requested to cause an Act to be introduced into the 1973 Session of the General Assembly effecting such exemption.
