
Dear Mr. Formicola:

Now that the frigid temperatures have risen and the damaged 24-inch water main behind the Federal Building has been repaired, I would like to take this opportunity to thank you and your department personnel for the extra effort which you provided during the flooding emergency of January 12.

Working through the night with our own staff and members of your department, it was possible to see firsthand the problems that your department faces during the extreme winter temperatures which we have experienced this year. Your understanding and willingness to let us operate with the 2-inch supply line which was discovered on Westminster Street permitted us to provide a reasonable amount of building service for approximately 1,500 people at 15 Westminster Street until the major repairs were made.

We appreciate the prompt and courteous attention that was given to our problem during this emergency period. Without your assistance the bank and its numerous tenants would undoubtedly have had to curtail their operations.
