

Dear Mayor Elorza:

Director Borg is requesting approval to pay American Development Institute LLC (d/b/a/ ADI Energy) for energy efficiency work done at the Dexter Street Garage and the Police Academy.

In July of 2016 an EBF Loan with Rhode Island Infrastructure Bank (RIIB) was secured by the City, for Energy Efficiency Work at three fire stations and the Dexter Street Garage and the Police Academy. Invoices were submitted directly to RIIB and vendors were paid directly. That loan has closed and there are no additional funds available.

The loan was for \$1,252,000. From that amount, there were disbursements applied: CAP-1 disbursements, and the loan origination fee. These disbursements resulted in a shortfall from the loan to what was owed the vendors.

Therefore Director Borg is requesting approval to pay ADI Energy for the balance of what is owed them, in the amount of 136,062.91

Funds are available in 101-1801 52940.
