



I am very much aware of the residency requirement in the Providence Home Rule Charter and had every intention on moving into the City within the six months allotted me. I have been working in the position of Network Engineer in the Data Processing Department. My primary function is to implement and maintain the computer aided dispatch system for Police and Fire. The duration of this project was not known at the time I began my employment and my future here within the City was not secure. During the implementation of the Public Safety system it has become certain that this project will be on-going and this position plays an important role in the continued success of that system.

My parents and my wife's parents are elderly and their health has deteriorated drastically over the past year. 

Dear Mr. Clement,

In accordance with Section 1210, Residence Requirement: Exemptions, I am hereby requesting a waiver of residency in accordance with the rules stated therein.

In 1997 I was recruited by Roger Williams Middle School to fill a position in the Dance Department because there were not any qualified/certified staff available in the Providence School Department. I worked in that position for two years as a long-term substitute under an emergency certificate for Dance while I finished the required coursework. In September 1999 I was appointed and upgraded to probationary status.

To my knowledge, there is not currently a certified dance educator on the Providence substitute or faculty list that meets both the certification and residency requirements. Therefore, I respectfully request that I be exempt from this requirement on the basis that I am in a "hard to fill" area as deemed so by the Providence School Department of Human Resources.
