REPORT FROM COMMITTEE

COUNCILWOMAN CAROLYN F. BRASSIL, Chairwoman COMMITTEE ON FINANCE

The following Ordinance was in City Council April 15, 1982 Referred Back to the Committee on Finance and is Transmitted without Recommendation, as Amended:

An Ordinance in Amendment of Chapter 1979-37 approved September 28, 1979, entitled: "An Ordinance Regulating the Use of Interceptors, Public and Private Sewers and Drains, the Installation and Connection of Building Sewers and Garbage Disposal Units, the Discharge of

Water and Wastewater into the Public Sewerage System and Providing for the Enforcement of these Rules and Regulations and Cost Recovery Program in the City of Providence, County of Providence, State of Rhode Island and Providence Plantations", as Amended.

COUNCILMAN JOHNSON Moves the Ordinance be Read and Passed the First Time.

This motion is seconded by COUNCILMAN EASTON.

COUNCILMAN DILLON Moves the Ordinance be Amended as follows:

Page 2, Section 3, Paragraph 2, Line 1, the amount of "Fifty-Five Dollars (\$55.00)" shall be amended to read "Thirty-Three Dollars (\$33.00)".

Page 5, Section 14, Paragraph 1, following the last line of said Paragraph the following sentence shall be added: "The amount of Seven Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000.00) shall be transferred from the General Fund to the Sewer Fund on or before June 30, 1982".

This motion is seconded by COUNCILMAN O'CONNOR.

COUNCILMAN PEARLMAN moves the Amendment be Laid on the Table for further study.

This motion being seconded by COUNCILMAN MOISE and having precedence over the Motion to Amend, is Put to Vote and Not Passed, by the following Roll Call Vote:
