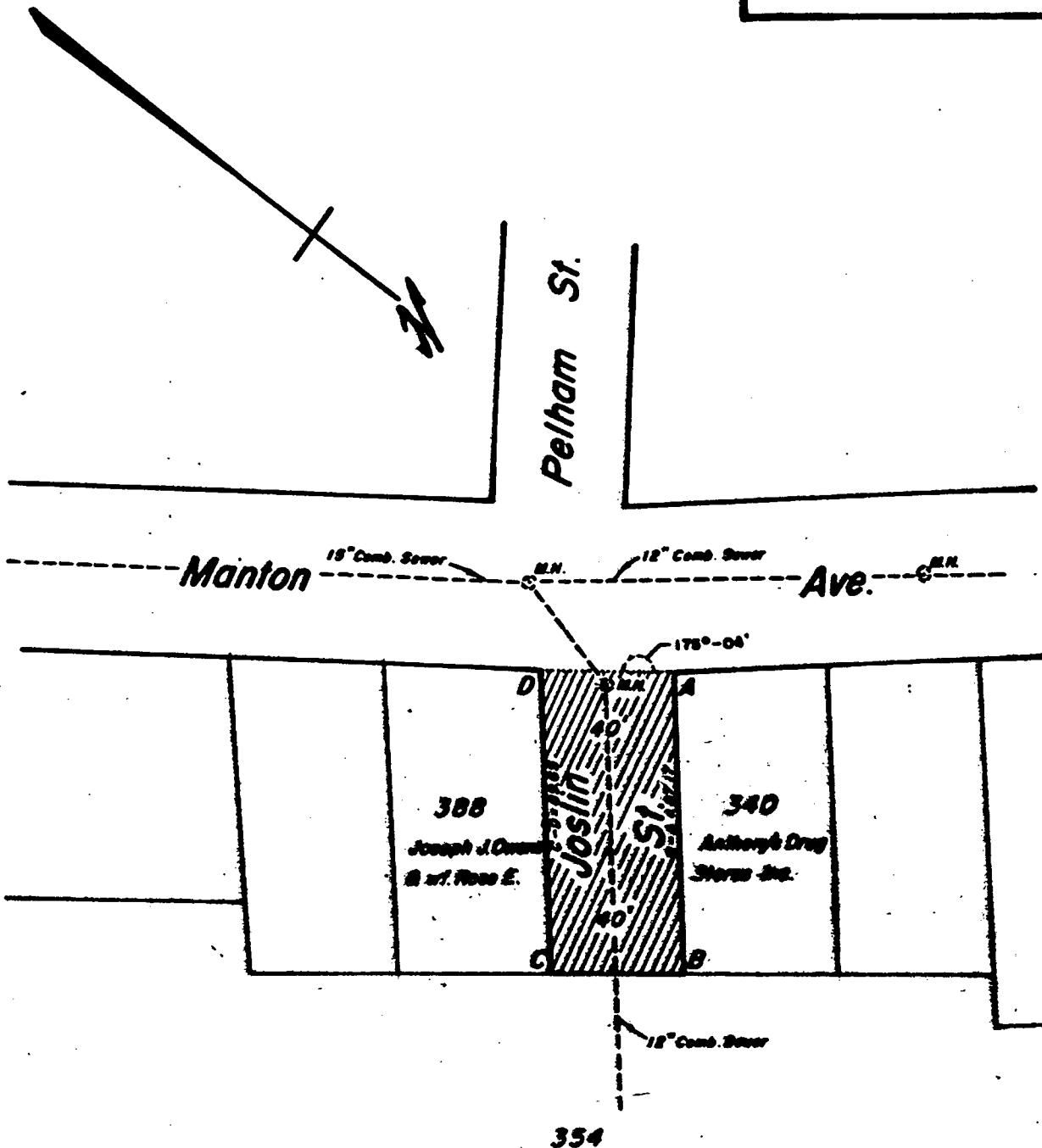


Dear Councilman Payne:

On June 11, 1973 we received a memorandum from the City Clerk's Office with regard to a petition filed by Anthony's Drug Stores, Inc., Mr. Anthony Joseph Solomon, to abandon as a Public Highway that portion of Joslin Street, Providence, from its intersection with Manton Avenue northerly approximately ninety (90) feet.

We have arrived at a cost estimate of one thousand one hundred and eleven dollars and twenty four cents (\$1,111.24). This includes the re-production costs of facilities abandoned, installation of a plug in Manton Avenue water main and the installation of a 3/4-inch copper service, exclusive of highway costs, from the main in Manton Avenue to one foot inside the curb.

A bill for the above amount will be filed with the City Collector's Office and we respectfully request that your Committee take no action on this matter until the Water Supply Board is assured of payment for the work and material involved.
