

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 448

Approved May 9, 1979

WHEREAS, funds are needed to support the preparation and training of American Athletes for the 1980 Olympic Games, and

WHEREAS, in recognition of this need, and in keeping with its fifty year tradition of service to the community the Olneyville Boys Club sponsored an Olympathon to raise funds for that purpose on April 21, 1979, and

WHEREAS, the cooperation of the North Providence-Johnston Boys Club, the Wanskuck Boys Club, the Nickerson House and the Fiskeville Flyers was solicited in this momentous effort, and

WHEREAS, the obstacle course which was constructed by the staff and Members of the Club would have tested the skill and endurance of the Olympic Athletes themselves, and

WHEREAS, in the course of eight hours the Olympathon participants traversed the grueling course well over five hundred times, one team completing it forty times within its allotted half hour, and

WHEREAS, a total of \$3,036.59 was pledged for the support of Olympic Athletes as a result of these efforts,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Members of the City Council extend to the staff and Members of the Olneyville Boys Club its congratulations on the success of "Olympathon 1979",

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon the adoption of this Resolution by the City Council and its approval by His Honor the Mayor, the City Clerk is directed to transmit a duly engrossed copy of this Resolution to the Olneyville Boys Club.
