NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Director of the Department of Building Inspection is requested to cause the securing of the doors on that structure located at 149 Burnett Street so that the residents of that immediate vicinity can alleviate their fears of the possibility of a conflagration at that site which may effect the residents abutting the said property.
