

Gentlemen:

The Traffic Engineering Department has reviewed the all-rolling parking regulations on Broadway as requested by the City Council.

The need for these regulations was most apparent during the recent storm period. Now that the threat of continued severe storms has passed, these regulations can be modified. However, the observations made during the past three weeks clearly indicate the necessity for being able to maintain an efficient two-lane movement during the afternoon rush hour at the western end of the street. For this reason the all-rolling regulation between 4:00 p.m., and 6:00 p.m., is being continued on the northerly side of Broadway between Almy Street and the Expressway Ramp.


