CHAPTER 909

No. 587 AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT OF THE ZONING MAP, WHICH IS PART OF THE ZONING ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 544, OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE, APPROVED SEPTEMBER 21, 1951, AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ZONING THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE AND ESTABLISHING USE, HEIGHT, AND AREA REGULATIONS".

Approved November 19, 1954

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1: The Zoning Map accompanying and made a part of Chapter 544, approved September 21, 1951, entitled "An Ordinance Zoning the City of Providence and Establishing Use, Height, and Area Regulations" is hereby amended by changing:

From a General Commercial C-2 Zone to a Heavy Commercial C-4 Zone
Lot 49 and part of Lot 50 on Assessor's Plat 32. (Westminster Street at Knight Street). Bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the southwesterly line of Knight Street at the southeasterly corner of Lot 49 on Assessor's Plat 32; thence westerly along the southerly line of said Lot 49 to the southwesterly corner of said Lot 49; thence southerly along the easterly line of Lot 50 to the intersection of the said easterly line of Lot 50 and a line one hundred (100) feet southwesterly from and parallel with the southwesterly line of Knight Street; thence northwesterly along the said last described line to the present northerly boundary of the General Commercial Zone (C-2); thence easterly along the said present northerly boundary of the General Commercial Zone (C-2) to the southwesterly line of Knight Street; thence southeasterly along the said southwesterly line of Knight Street to the point and place of beginning.

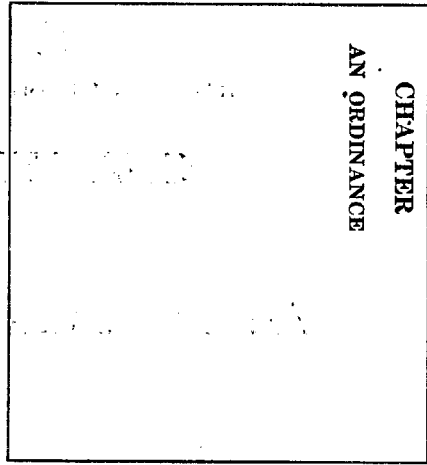
From a General Residence R-3 Zone to a General Commercial C-2 Zone
Lots 253 and 255 on Assessor's Plat 112. (Plainfield Street at Killingly Street). Bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the easterly line of Lot 253 on Assessor's Plat 112 at the intersection of said line and the present westerly boundary of the General Residence Zone (R-3); thence northerly along the said westerly boundary of the General Residence Zone (R-3) crossing Lot 253 to the southerly boundary of the One-family Zone (R-1); thence easterly along the said present southerly boundary of the One-family (R-1) Zone crossing Lot 255 to the northerly line of Lot 254; thence westerly along the said northerly line of Lot 254 to the northwesterly corner of said Lot 254; thence southerly along the easterly line of Lot 253 to the point and place of beginning.

From a Limited Commercial C-1 Zone to a Heavy Commercial C-4 Zone
part of Lots 143, 147, 148, 149, 151, and 507 on Assessor's Plat 28. (Atwells Avenue between Marcello and Knight Streets). Bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the northeasterly line of Knight Street at the northwesterly corner of Lot 143 on Assessor's Plat 28; thence easterly along the southerly lines of Lots 145, 146, 508, and 150 to the westerly line of Marcello Street; thence southerly along the said westerly line of Marcello Street to a point one hundred (100) feet southerly from the southerly line of Atwells Avenue; thence westerly in a line one hundred (100) feet southerly from and parallel with the said southerly line of Atwells Avenue to the northeasterly line of Knight Street; thence northwesterly along the said northeasterly line of Knight Street to the point and place of beginning.

From a Limited Commercial C-1 Zone to a Heavy Commercial C-4 Zone part of Lot 165 on Assessor's Plat 9, and from a Heavy Commercial C-4 Zone to a Limited Commercial C-1 Zone part of Lots 122 and 123 on Assessor's Plat 9. (Captain Davis Boulevard at Olney Street and Burr's Lane).

Bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the easterly line of Captain J. Carleton Davis Memorial Boulevard at the northwesterly corner of Lot 165 on Assessor's Plat 9; thence easterly along the northerly line of said Lot 165 to the second angle east of Captain J. Carleton Davis Memorial Boulevard; thence westerly in the range of the present southerly boundary of the Heavy Commercial Zone (C-4) to the easterly line of Captain J. Carleton Davis Memorial Boulevard; thence northerly along the said easterly line of Captain J. Carleton Davis Memorial Boulevard to the northwesterly corner of Lot 165 and the point and place of beginning.

Beginning at a point in the southerly line of Olney Street at the northeasterly corner of Lot 123 on Assessor's Plat 9; thence southerly along the easterly line of said Lot 123 to the southwesterly corner of Lot 124; thence westerly along the northerly line of Lot 165 to a point in the range of the present easterly boundary of the Heavy Commercial Zone (C-4) (north of Olney Street) to the southerly line of Olney Street; thence easterly along the said southerly line of Olney Street to the northeasterly corner of Lot 123 and the point and place of beginning.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

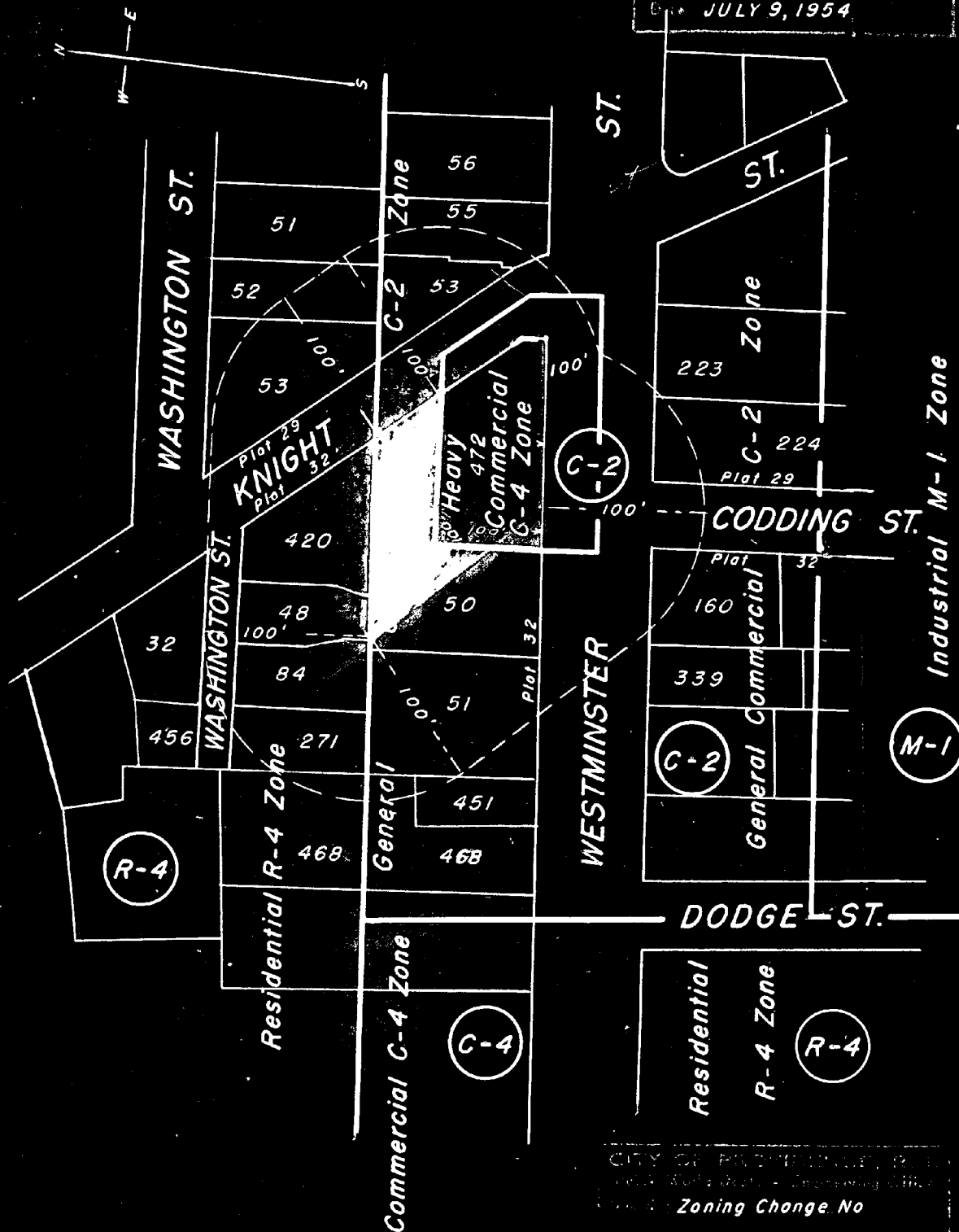

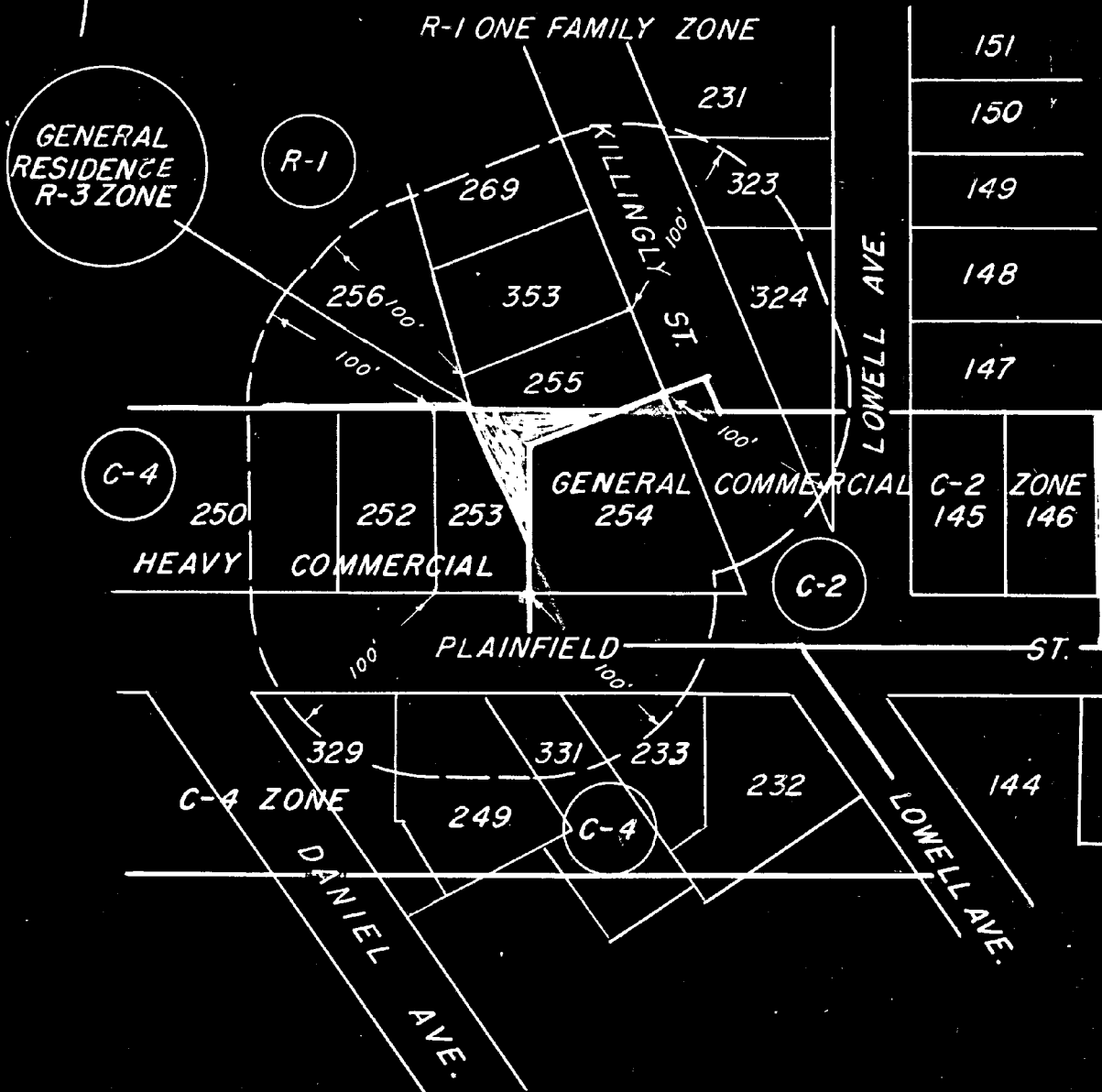

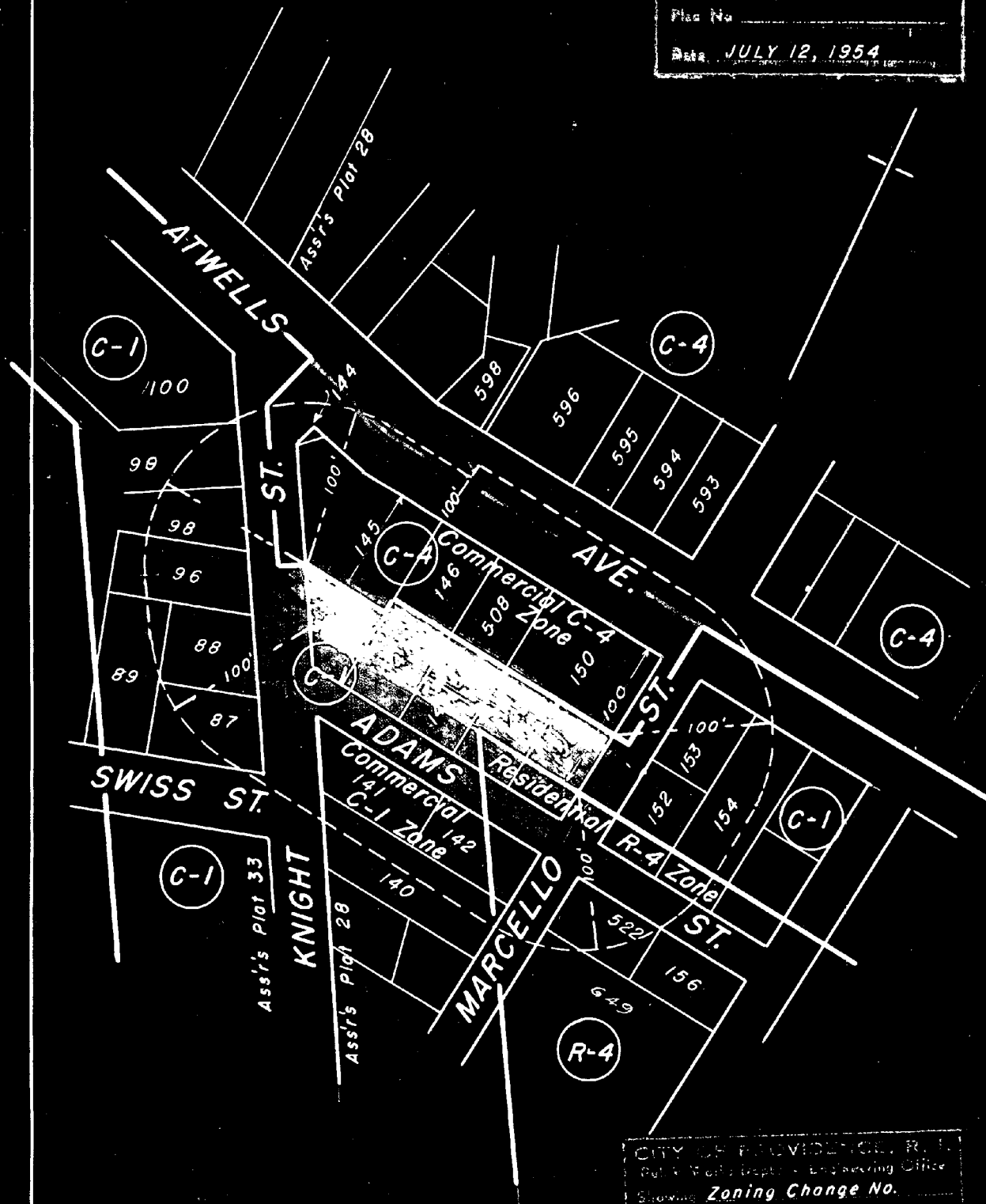

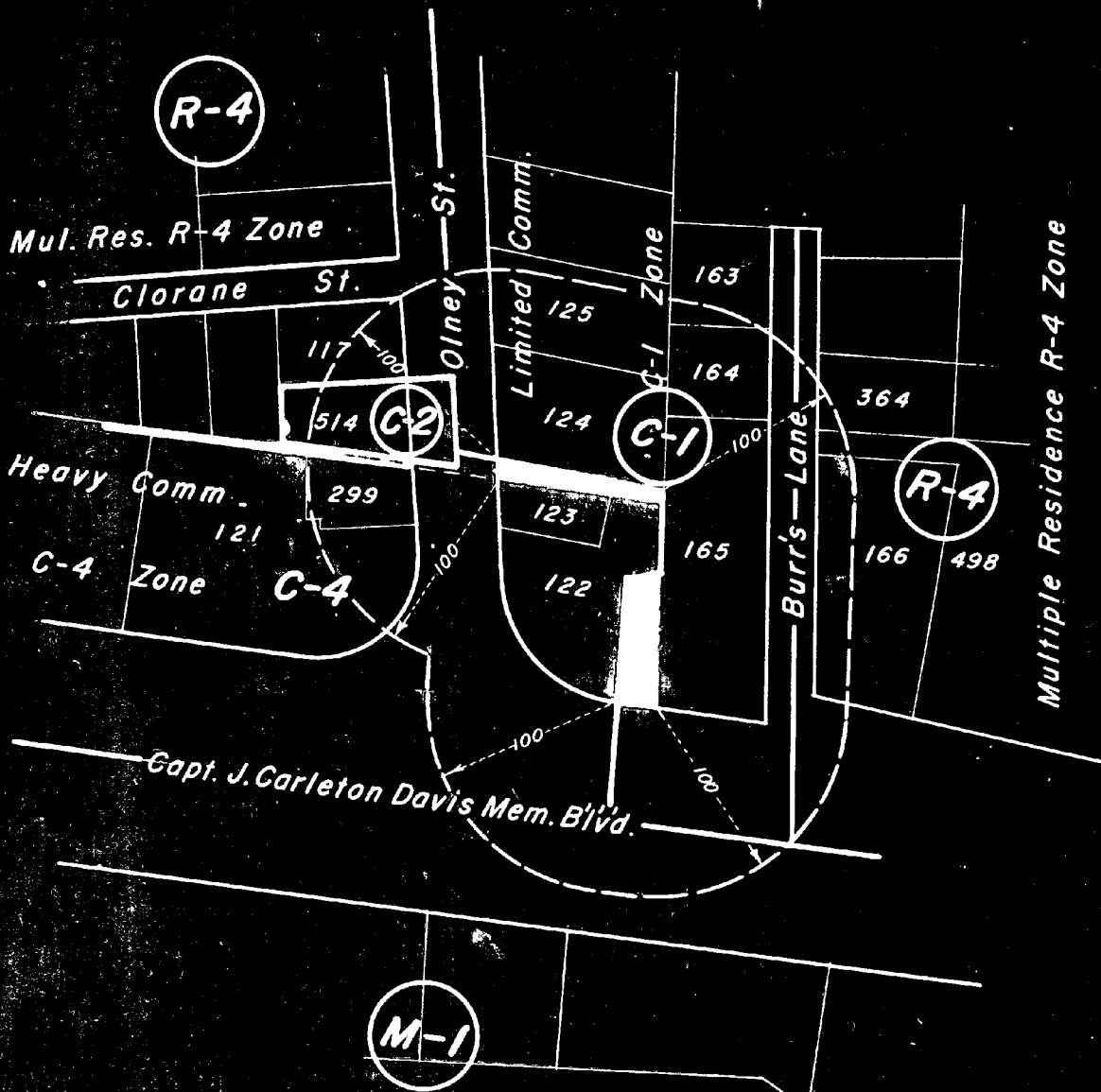

No. 588 AN ORDINANCE

AMENDING CHAPTER 887, SECTION 20

OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE APPROVED SEPTEMBER 17, 1954.

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1: Chapter 887 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence approved September 17, 1954, is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 20: POLICE DEPARTMENT

That part which has heretofore read:

"The number of employees in the POLICE DEPARTMENT shall not exceed six hundred thirty-two (632)"; shall hereafter read: "The number of employees in the POLICE DEPARTMENT shall not exceed six hundred thirty-three (633)".

Change: 10 Police Patrol Driver

to read:

11 Police Patrol Driver

SECTION 2: The additional position as added by this Ordinance shall be retroactive to October 1, 1954.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage.
