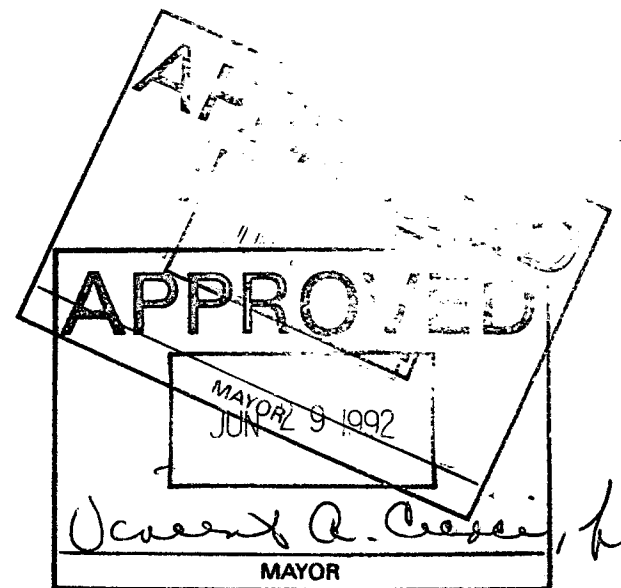

and



WHEREAS, Recently Ms. Brown recently gave birth to a
fictional son; and


WHEREAS, The character is unmarried; and

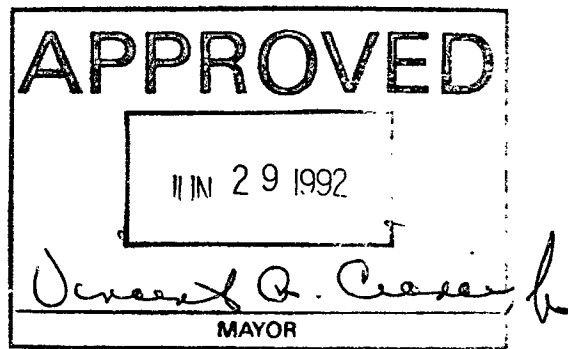
WHEREAS, The Vice-President of the United States, recently
