

WHEREAS, Recently Ms. Brown recently gave birth to a  
fictional son; and


WHEREAS, The character is unmarried; and

WHEREAS, The Team had previously won the Indoor Track State Championship, and


WHEREAS, The Girls Team was led by eight All Division athletes, and


WHEREAS, Five members of the team were named All-State, and
