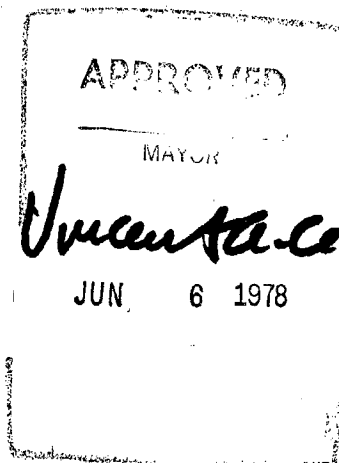
Approved June 6, 1978
