

# PETITION TO THE CITY COUNCIL

TO THE HONORABLE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE:

The undersigned respectfully petitions your honorable body to declare by appropriate order or decree that the portion of South Street bounded westerly by Eddy Street and easterly by land of The Narragansett Electric Company has ceased to be useful to the public and so to abandon the same as a public highway.

In aid of this petition, your petitioners respectfully represent:

1. That your petitioner, Davol Inc., owns the abutting land on the southerly side of said part of South Street and your petitioner, The Narragansett Electric Company, owns the abutting land on the northerly side of said part of South Street.

2. That the reason for seeking said abandonment is to enable your petitioners to integrate said part of South Street with their respective abutting lands so as to enable your petitioners to provide further security for their respective properties.

3. That any abandonment would be subject to the rights of the City of Providence to maintain water and sewer lines now or hereafter installed in said part of South Street.



The petition for the abandonment of portions of the above captioned streets have been studied by this department, and it is recommended that neither Aleppo Street nor South Street be abandoned, because of existing sewers within the streets. Aleppo Street contains a 36" combination sewer and a slot manhole. South Street contains a 12" sanitary sewer and also an 18" and 24" storm sewer.

It is recommended that Mathewson Street, (Between Fountain St. & Sabin St.) to the proposed street line of Sabin Street be abandoned as indicated on Plan No. 063573, P.W. Dept.-Engineering Office, Street Line Section, Date: August 15, 1972.

Gentlemen:

This petition from the Committee on Public Works requests the abandonment of South Street from Eddy Street westerly to its termination at the property of the Narragansett Electric Co.

The petitioners agree to retain water and sewer lines now existing or hereinafter installed on said section of South Street.

Inspection revealed that South Street as described runs from Eddy Street directly to a private parking area and gives access to nothing but the property of the petitioner along the entire length. It, therefore, provides no public use.

The Commission

VOTED: To accept the staff recommendation to offer no objection to the proposed abandonment subject to the rights of the City of Providence to maintain water and sewer lines now or hereafter installed in said part of South Street.


