RESOLUTION OF THE PROVIDENCE CITY COUNCIL
APPROVING THE THIRD YEAR COMPREHENSIVE
CITY DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM AND
AUTHORIZING AGREEMENT AND APPROVING
AMENDMENTS TO THE SECOND YEAR
COMPREHENSIVE CITY DEMONSTRATION
PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, The First Year Comprehensive City Demonstration Program for the Providence Model Neighborhood was approved by Resolution No. 35, adopted January 20, 1969;

WHEREAS, The Second Year Comprehensive City Demonstration Program for the Providence Model Neighborhood was approved by Resolution No. 284, adopted July 8, 1970;

WHEREAS, A Grant Agreement with the United States of America was executed to carry out the First Year Program on July 15, 1969, providing for Federal Financial Assistance under Title I of the Demonstration Cities and Metropolitan Development Act of 1966 (hereinafter called the "Act"), and said Grant Agreement was amended to provide Federal Financial Assistance for the Second Year Program on September 1, 1970;

WHEREAS, The City of Providence desires to carry out a Third Year Comprehensive City Demonstration Program (herein called the "Program", and attached hereto and made a part hereof) with Federal Financial Assistance under the Act;

WHEREAS, The Act requires local governing body approval of the Program as a condition for eligibility for continued Federal Financial Assistance;

WHEREAS, The Federal Government requires local governing body approval of Amendments to the Program when such an amendment includes projects and/or activities whose cumulative amount exceeds twenty-five percent of the total Grant Budget;

WHEREAS, The Mayor of the City of Providence must be authorized to submit the Third Year Action Program and to accept and execute the amended Grant Budget, and must be authorized to submit the Amendments to the Second Year Action Program (attached hereto and made a part hereof) and to accept and execute the revised Grant Budget;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the PROVIDENCE CITY COUNCIL that:

SEC. 1. The Third Year Action Program including the projects and/or activities described herein and set forth in the revised Grant Budget is hereby approved.

Sec. 2. The Amendment to the Second Year Action Program including eight additional projects and/or activities and set forth in detail in the material attached hereto and made a part hereof is hereby approved.

SEC. 3. The Mayor is hereby authorized to submit the Third Year Action Program and Second Year Action Program Amendments and to accept and execute the revised Grant Budgets (attached hereto and made a part hereof), with the United States of America, and to do all things necessary in order to carry out the Program, including the execution of Contracts with each operating agency or public body, the submission of such reports, certifications and other material as the Department of Housing and Urban Development shall require.

SEC. 4. The Providence City Council assumes full responsibility for assuring that all Grant Funds will be used in an economic and efficient manner in carrying out the Program and the Program as amended, and assures the necessary non-Federal share of the cost of Program Administration.

SEC. 5. The Finance Director of the City of Providence, or his successor or delegate, may do all things required to be done in order to obtain payment of the Grant, including but not limited to the selection of a commercial bank to receive payment vouchers, the submission of signature specimens and the filing of requests for payment.

SEC. 6. This Resolution shall take effect upon its approval.


This Agency also intends to submit to HUD its Third Year Action Program the week of the 5th of July, so that HUD may review the Third Year Program concurrently along with the City Council. This Agency will also submit to each councilman a synopsis of each of the projects and/or activities contained in the Third Year Action Program.

The program essentially requests City Council's approval of the Model Cities Program consisting of approximately thirty or more projects costing a total of approximately \$2.2 million, of which the City contribution is approximately \$70,000. The program concentrates its activities in the South Providence area bounded by Broad Street and the freeway. The program has operated for approximately two years and has met with some very good success

I feel certain that in our third year which is scheduled to begin September 1, 1971, and will carry through to August 31, 1972, the Model Cities Program would have achieved a marked degree of success.
