# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 477

Approved August 8, 1963

WHEREAS the PROVIDENCE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY on January 2, 1962 did condemn for the Central-Classical Redevelopment Project, certain real property owned by the City of Providence, as Trustee under the Will of Anna H. Man, viz:

LOTS numbered 236, 240 and 313 on Assessor's Plat 29.

WHEREAS the PROVIDENCE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY has offered the sum of EIGHTY-THREE THOUSAND (\$83,000.00) Dollars for lot 313 on Assessor's Plat 29 and the sum of EIGHTEEN THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED (\$18,900.00) Dollars for lot 240 on Assessor's Plat 29, and the sum of ELEVEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED (\$11,500.00) Dollars for lot 236 on Assessor's Plat 29, as the fair value of said real estate; and

WHEREAS the Central Real Estate Co., Inc. was the holder of a leasehold interest in said lot 313 on Assessor's Plat 29, and

WHEREAS the fair market value of said leasehold interest of the Central Real Estate Co. has been determined to be FORTY-FIVE HUNDRED (\$4,500.00) Dollars, which said sum will be deducted from the proceeds of lot 313 and paid to said Central Real Estate Co., and

WHEREAS the Board of Commissioners of Sinking Funds of the City of Providence has VOTED to accept the offers of the Providence Redevelopment Agency for the aforescribed properties,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the City of Providence ratifies and confirms the VOTE of said Sinking Fund Commission, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,

That His Honor the Mayor be and hereby is authorized for and on behalf of the City of Providence, in its capacity as Trustee under the will of Anna H. Man to execute Trustee's deeds and any other documents necessary to consummate these transactions and to convey to the Providence Redevelopment Agency the following parcels of land with all buildings and improvements thereon in consideration of the payment of the amounts as respectively set forth:

Lot 240 on Assessor's Plat 29, located on Cranston Street,	18,900.00

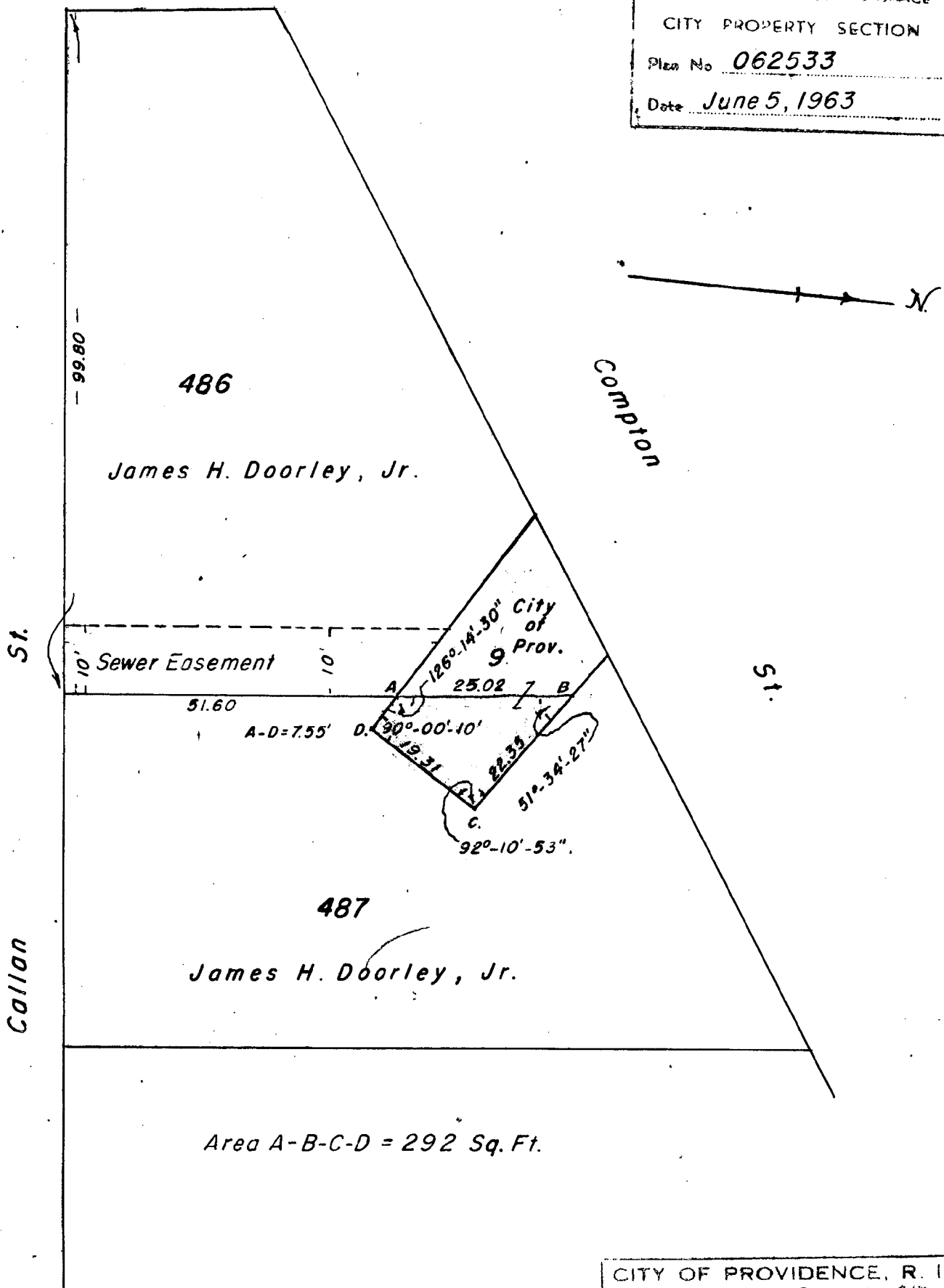

# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 481

Approved August 8, 1963

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 436, approved July 11, 1963, heretofore duly adopted, has authorized the Providence Redevelopment Agency to lease land in that certain area bounded by Fountain, Aborn, Washington and Beverly Streets in the City of Providence, to Providence Off-Street Parking Inc. for the erection thereon of a multistory parking facility containing approximately 440 low-cost parking spaces; and

WHEREAS, Providence Off-Street Parking, Inc. is now ready to proceed with the development of said facility; and

WHEREAS Revenue Ruling 63-20 provides that the corporation must have been approved by the state or a political subdivision thereof, either of which must also have approved the specific obligations issued by the corporation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Council hereby approves and ratifies the creation of Providence Off-Street Parking, Inc., and further approves the issuance by it of ONE MILLION ONE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND (\$1,150,000) DOLLARS Providence Off-Street Parking, Inc., Series 1963, First Mortgage Parking Revenue Bonds, dated August 1, 1963, and maturing serially in each of the years 1965 to 1993, both inclusive, to be secured by an Indenture of Mortgage, dated August 1, 1963, to be made and entered into by and between Providence Off-Street Parking, Inc. and Industrial National Bank of Rhode Island; provided, however, that nothing herein shall be construed in any manner as pledging or encumbering the faith and credit of the City of Providence.

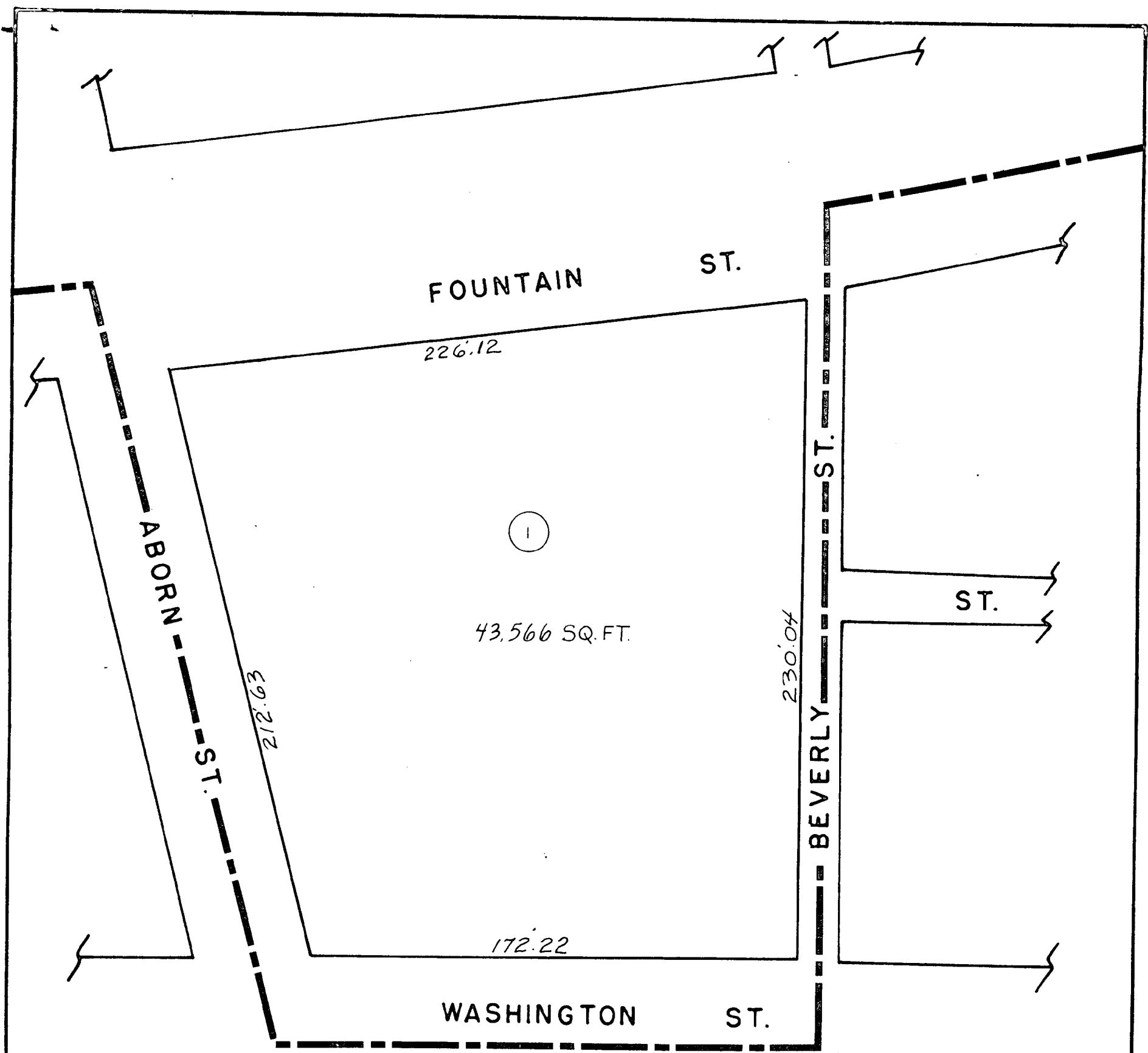
