

# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 485

Approved November 16, 2009

WHEREAS, The Big East Conference is a major national collegiate athletic conference;  
and

WHEREAS, The Big East has 17 member schools, including Providence College; and

WHEREAS, Their student athletes compete at the highest level in 23 different sports,  
including 10 men's and 13 women's; and

WHEREAS, The Big East has been one of the most successful NCAA conferences, with  
10 men's basketball championships, 6 women's basketball championships, and numerous bowl  
game victories in Division 1A football; and

WHEREAS, Since its inception in 1979, the Big East Conference has had its national  
headquarters in downtown Providence; and

WHEREAS, The Providence headquarters has 33 fulltime employees; and

WHEREAS, The commissioner of the Big East Conference, John Marinatto, is a lifetime  
Providence resident and Providence College graduate; and

WHEREAS, The Big East Conference needs to relocate because the lease at its current  
location is expiring soon; and


WHEREAS, Having a large and successful national organization such as the Big East  
Conference in Providence is a boon to both local economy and local prestige.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the City Council of the City of

Providence.


