RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 156

Approved March 19, 1973

WHEREAS, the City of Providence, under the provisions of Chapter 834 of the Public Laws of 1940, has the authority to regulate and license automobile parking places in the said City, including the establishment of a system of fees and charges, and

WHEREAS, there is presently pending before the House Committee on Corporations, House Act 73-H 5363, which provides for the licensing of parking facilities, an annual license fee of Fifty Dollars for each facility and rules and regulations including rates that shall be established by the Department of Business Regulation,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the General Assembly is hereby requested to amend the existing authority of the City of Providence to license and regulate automobile parking places, to increase the maximum fee to Fifty Dollars per parking place per annum, and to further exempt the said City from the provisions of said House Act 73-H 5363, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon the adoption of this Resolution, the City Clerk is directed to transmit to the Chairman of the House Committee on Corporations of the General Assembly of Rhode Island a duly certified copy of this Resolution.
