RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Approved February 12, 1981

RESOLVED, DECREED AND ORDERED

That the following named street shown as cross-hatched area on the accompanying plan entitled "Providence, Rhode Island, Department of Public Works - Engineering Office, Street Line Section Plan No. 064132, dated December 19, 1980",

VIZ:

Manning Street, for one block between Thayer and Brook Streets shown as cross-hatched area on the accompanying plan and designated by the letters (A-B-C-D-A), having ceased to be useful to the public and is proposed to be abandoned as a Public Highway, subject to the petitioners conveying easements acceptable to the following; The Water Supply Board to secure a permanent easement equivalent to present street width and length; Narragansett Electric Company be permitted the retention of their facilities in existing locations on said streets, together with the right to inspect, maintain, operate and replace the same; Providence Gas Company be permitted the right to inspect, improve and maintain their present facilities at all times; and that the Department of Public Works is provided a full sewer easement; and the damage to the abutters is appraised at nothing and so awarded, and it is further

ORDERED, That the Director of Public Works be and he is hereby directed to cause a sign to be placed on the above-named highway abandoned as aforesaid, having thereon the words, "Not a Public Highway", and it is further

ORDERED, That after the entry of this order or decree the City Clerk shall cause a notice thereof to be published in a newspaper published in the County of Providence at least once a week for three successive weeks and a further and personal notice shall be served by the City Sergeant upon every owner of land abutting the above-named highway which have been abandoned, who is known to reside within the State.


Dear Councilman Flynn:

On September 24, 1980, this department received from the City Clerk a memorandum and a copy of petition to abandon a portion of Manning Street, for one block between Thayer and Brook Streets.

We have checked into this request and find that in the portion of Manning Street to be abandoned we have a 6" C.I. water main which is feeding three (3) active water services on Brook Street, namely house #15, 20, and #358. For this reason we cannot abandon this section unless we secure a permanent easement equivalent to present street width and length. This area must be accessible to us at all times for any repair work necessary.


The City Plan Commission at its October 28, 1980 regular meeting evaluated the petition for the abandonment of that portion of Manning Street from the westerly side of Brook Street to its westerly termination at the easterly side of Thayer Street. This petition was submitted by Brown University. The blocks adjoining each side of that portion of Manning Street in question are owned by the petitioner, Brown University.

A field inspection revealed that the portion of Manning Street from Brook Street to Hope Street was abandoned in 1964 for the construction of the Physics and Engineering Complex. The portion of Manning Street in question has become the only remaining portion of its westerly termination and is an improved public right-of-way. There are structures at both sides of the street and they are used for academic purposes by Brown University. The major users of this street are the University personnel and its students. The abandonment of this portion of the street will neither affect the traffic circulation pattern of this area nor any property other than that of the petitioner. Therefore,



Dear Sirs:

The Narragansett Electric Company presently has overhead electrical facilities on each proposed abandoned portion of the subject streets, including poles and wires for streetlighting on Hanover and Manning Streets (necessary if area lighting is required upon abandonment), a guy stub and guy wires on Williams Street which support pole lines on Gano and Williams Streets and guy wires on Hanover Street which support outrigged crossarms on Hanover Street at Dexter Street.

However, The Narragansett Electric Company will not object to the granting of said petitions, provided that in the event the petitions are granted, the Petitioners will convey easements acceptable to The Narragansett which will permit the retention of our facilities in existing locations on said streets, together with the right to inspect, maintain, operate and replace the same.


