RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Approved August 10, 1978

WHEREAS, In the past three years, Section 8 funds have been allocated in greater amounts to New Construction and Substantial Rehabilitation, and

WHEREAS, It has been determined that less than 25% of the Section 8 Units, allocated to Providence, have been to the Existing Section 8 Program, and

WHEREAS, It is apparent that the Section 8 Program has turned into a developer's program for the construction of new housing and does not help in the rehabilitation of existing housing, which constitutes the neighborhoods,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the City Council of the City of Providence, hereby requests the Department of Housing and Urban Development and the Mayor's Office of Community Development to cause the allocation of more Section 8 Funds to existing private housing,
