Governor Sundlun announced the appointment of Stanley Weiss to the Capital Center Commission. Stanley Weiss is the Managing Partner of University Heights Associates which owns the University Heights Shopping Center in addition to other real estate holdings. Recently, Mr. Weiss personally purchased the landmark Tilden Thurber building in the old downtown retail core.

Mr. Weiss came to Providence, Rhode Island, under a National Science Foundation Fellowship to study urban sociology at Brown University in 1966. He holds his graduate degree from the University of Michigan where he studied under a Metropolitan Community Research Fellowship. His undergraduate work was completed at the City University of New York. His career after Brown was in banking, where he was a vice president at Citizen's Bank responsible for the Personal Trust Division.

While Mr. Weiss devotes his current time to his personal investments at the Halsey House on Prospect Street, which is currently being restored to its original state, he also devotes himself to community activities. He is currently a Trustee and Treasurer of the Providence Foundation which held its annual meeting this year at the Tilden Thurber building. He also is a Commissioner of the Providence Review Commission and has also served as Commissioner on the Port of Providence.
