




RESOLVED, that the Board of Contract and Supply is hereby empowered and authorized to purchase from the Providence Redevelopment Agency that certain parcel of land know as Assessor's Plat 8 Lot 10 located in the Lippitt Hill, the parcel contains approximately 8,150 square feet, at a cost of One Dollar (\$1.00). This parcel, which has been developed as a city park. The parcel is to be transferred to the Parks Department, for park purposes.

The Providence Redevelopment Agency is requesting, that the Council does hereby cancel or abate, in whole, the taxes assessed upon the mentioned property, in accordance with Rhode Island General Law Section 44-7-23, or any taxes accrued including 2002 taxes.
