No. 181 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE CHAPTER 1143

BY APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF FIVE HUNDRED (\$500) DOLLARS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF RHODE ISLAND, AMERICAN LEGION CONVENTION, INC.

Approved April 7, 1958

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1: Chapter 1143 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence as approved September 20, 1957, and entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$36,161,545.40 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1958", as amended, is hereby further amended by appropriating the sum of Five Hundred (\$500) Dollars to the DEPARTMENT OF RHODE ISLAND, AMERICAN LEGION CONVENTION, INC.

SECTION 2: The money hereby appropriated shall be paid to the Treasurer of the 1958 American Legion Convention, Inc., to help defray the expenses of the Annual State Convention of the Department of the American Legion to be held in the City of Providence, June 20th, 21st, and 22nd, 1958.

SECTION 3: The said sum of Five Hundred (\$500) Dollars as hereby appropriated shall be obtained by authorizing and directing the City Controller and City Treasurer to transfer a like amount from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account to the Receipt Account.

SECTION 4: The Estimated Receipts from Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures are hereby increased by the sum of Five Hundred (\$500) Dollars.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.



BY APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF THIRTEEN THOUSAND (\$13,000) DOLLARS TO
CITY SERGEANT, ITEM 1.

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1: Chapter 1143 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, as approved September 20, 1957, entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$36,161,545.40 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1958", as amended, is hereby further amended by appropriating the sum of Thirteen Thousand (\$13,000) Dollars to CITY SERGEANT, ITEM 1.

SECTION 2: The said sum of Thirteen Thousand (\$13,000) Dollars as thus added and appropriated shall be obtained by authorizing and directing the City Controller and the City Treasurer to transfer a like amount from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures to the Receipt Account.

SECTION 3: The Estimated Receipts from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures are hereby increased by Thirteen Thousand (\$13,000) Dollars.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.



No. 184

Approved April 7, 1958

Whereas, the Sovereign State of Israel will, on the 24th day of April, 1958, celebrate her Tenth Anniversary as a Free Nation, symbolizing the combined efforts and culmination of the struggle for a respected place in the World of Nations, and

WHEREAS, in the vanguard of Nations, the United States of America, under the then-humanitarian leadership of its President, Harry S. Truman, recognized the State of Israel as a Sovereignty, and

WHEREAS, millions of people throughout the Free World, in joining with her in acclaiming the toil, sacrifice and vision in the cause of Democracy and Faith, enabling this Independent State to act as a Haven for millions of displaced and harrassed immigrants, restoring their dignity, equality and self-sufficiency as members of a Free Democratic State, and

WHEREAS, fortified with the knowledge, comfort and pride of a State of their own, the inhabitants of the World of Hebrew Faith, as manifested in the past, will continue to contribute to the culture, peace and progress of the World in general and the State of Israel in particular,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that His Honor, Mayor Walter H. Reynolds and the Members of the City Council, on behalf of themselves and the Citizens of the City of Providence, extend to the Sovereign State of Israel, its best wishes for continued development of peaceful and successful achievements and progress, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a certified copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the Tenth Anniversary Committee in Providence for transmittal to the Government of the State of Israel as a manifestation of the admiration of the Citizens of the City of Providence, in the celebration of this, the First Decade of the existence of the State of Israel.
