COUNCIL PRESIDENT HAXTON calls for further nominations.

COUNCILMAN PEARLMAN nominates WILLIAM I. MATZNER, ESQUIRE, of Providence, and this nomination is seconded by COUNCILMAN BRADSHAW.


COUNCIL PRESIDENT HAXTON calls for further nominations and there are none.
