



## REPORT TO THE CITY COUNCIL

The Honorable City Council

Gentlemen:

The Providence Redevelopment Agency, in accordance with the provisions of Paragraph 12 of Chapter 1044 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, approved July 12, 1956, and Title 45, Chapter 32, Section 5 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, hereby reports the proposed sale of property to Corliss Realty Company, Inc. within the West River Project No. UR R. I. 1-6.

Corliss Realty Company, Inc. of the City of Providence desires to purchase a portion of a certain building, known as the Newman-Gross Corporation Building, which is described in the attached agreement. This purchase is in addition to the land purchased by this corporation as reported on February 16, 1959. It is believed that this agreement complies with all the provisions of the Official Redevelopment Plan, as amended, for the project area.

This prospective purchaser is the owner of an industrial plant adjacent to the project area, and this proposed sale will allow the purchaser to expand his present facilities and to utilize his existing facilities to the maximum.

Negotiations with the owner were carried on in accordance with Part B 4 (i) of the Redevelopment Plan as amended which allows this Agency to negotiate the sale of property to owners of adjacent industrial plants for off-street parking and loading or for expansion purposes, and Part E 2 of the Redevelopment Plan as amended by Chapter 1366 of the Ordinances of the Providence City Council for the year, 1960, approved October 6, 1960. The proposed sales price is \$2,000.

SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT

This SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT made and entered into this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 1960 by and between the PROVIDENCE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, hereinafter referred to as the "AGENCY" and COLLIER REALTY CO., INC., hereinafter referred to as "COLLIER".

WITNESSETH THAT:

WHEREAS, the parties hereto have heretofore on the 25th day of March, 1959 entered into an agreement for the sale and purchase of a certain tract or lot of land within the West River Project Area, No. UB R.I. 1-5; and

WHEREAS, COLLIER, in addition to the above purchase, desires to buy a portion of a certain building, hereinafter more particularly described, known as the Henman-Gross Corp. Building (formerly situated on a portion of Lot No. 45 on Assessor's Plat No. 100, 52 West River Street) situated on the land which is the subject matter of the aforesaid agreement dated March 25, 1959; and

WHEREAS, COLLIER has offered to redevelop such property for and in accordance with the uses specified in the Redevelopment Plan for the West River Project Area and in accordance with the Construction Plan and Specifications approved by the AGENCY; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto have agreed to change, alter and modify said agreement of March 25, 1959 in those respects as of the date set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the payments which have already been made upon the original agreement, and for and in consideration of the further covenants and agreements herein set forth, it is now agreed by and between the said parties:

1. That certain Agreement entered into on March 25, 1959, between the parties hereto shall be and is hereby modified, altered and changed in the following respects:

c) The AGENCY agrees to sell and COLLINS agrees to buy "as is", exclusive of the land thereunder, that portion of the said Heenan-Cross Corp. building (formerly situated on a portion of Lot No. 63 on Assessor's Plat No. 100, 31 West River Street) consisting of a two (2) story masonry type building, described as follows:

The westerly fifty (50') feet of said Heenan-Cross Corp. building comprising approximately two thousand eight hundred (2,800) square feet, more or less.

b) Said premises are to be conveyed on or before December 31, 1960 by a good and sufficient bargain and sale deed by the AGENCY conveying the said premises free from all encumbrances except as to those encumbrances and restrictions set forth in said agreement of March 25, 1959 and for such convenience COLLINS is to pay the sum of Two Thousand and 09/100 (\$2,000.00) Dollars of which Two Hundred and 00/100 (\$200.00) Dollars has been paid this date and One Thousand Eight Hundred (\$1,800.00) Dollars are to be paid upon delivery of the deed.

e) That COLLINS further agrees to complete the construction and installation of improvements in accordance with said approved Construction Plans and Specifications submitted to said AGENCY within one (1) year from the tender of the deed.

d) That all assessments against said portion of the building, if any, shall be apportioned as of the day of the delivery of the deed.

e) The risk of loss or damage by fire between the date of sale and date of delivery of the deed is assumed by COLLINS.

f) It is further understood that the work of demolition and removal to grade of the portion of the building and/or structure to be razed and removed, shall be at the sole expense of the AGENCY and that the AGENCY shall in its sole discretion determine the adequacy and extent of both the demolition and the removal to grade.

g) That COLLINS will release the AGENCY from all claims and demands and waives whatever rights and/or remedies, both in law and equity, it may have against said AGENCY on account of or by reason of the removal or demolition of said portion of the Heenan-Cross Corp. building and by reason of rough grading.

b) That the time for conveyance as set forth in the agreement of March 25, 1959 is extended to December 31, 1960.

1) That this Agreement is supplemental to the contract of March 25, 1959 and said contract of March 25, 1959 is by reference made a part hereof, and all the terms, conditions and provisions thereof (unless specifically modified herein) are to apply hereto and are made a part hereof the same as though they were expressly re-written, incorporated, and included therein.

2) It is to be understood that this Agreement shall in no way act as a waiver of any of the conditions and obligations imposed upon the parties by the former agreement heretofore executed between them, and any rights which the parties may have by virtue of such former agreement are to be considered as of full force and effect.

3) That this Supplemental Agreement is made subject to the obtaining of the written consent of each and every leasee or purchaser of property within the West River Project Area affected by the proposed sale and is further subject to the approval of the Administrator of the Housing and Home Finance Agency and shall not be effective until at least ten days after the City Council of the City of Providence has received from the AGENCY a report concerning said sale. In the event the Administrator of the Housing and Home Finance Agency does not give his approval to this agreement or in the event the AGENCY does not submit to the City Council of the City of Providence a report concerning this agreement then this agreement is to be null and void, and all sums paid hereunder shall be refunded and the rights and obligations of the parties hereto shall cease.

4. This SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT is authorized by Resolution No. 759 of the PROVIDENCE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY approved September 13, 1960.
