RESOLVED, That His Honor the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a Deed of Conveyance to Marr Scaffolding Company, One D Street, South Boston, Massachusetts, of that certain tract or parcel of land situated along the northerly side of Ernest Street, in the Fields Point Section of the City of Providence, as set out and delineated on Lot 255 City Assessor's Plat 56, at a purchase price of Eighty Thousand, Eight Hundred Eighty-Three Dollars, (\$80,883.00), and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That in accordance with the lease Agreements made on the 11th Day of March, A.D., 1970 and on the 27th Day of December A.D., 1974, between the City of Providence and Marr Scaffolding Company, any rents paid to the City shall be applied to the purchase price.

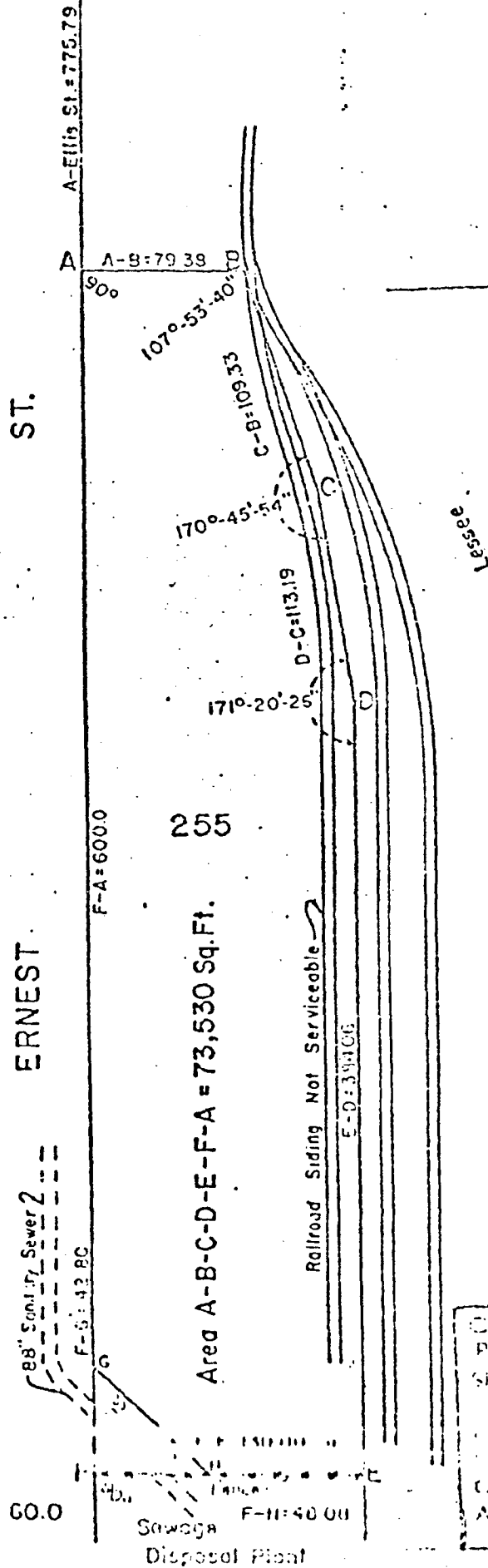
