AN ACT

AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE TO CONTRIBUTE FORTY-FIVE HUNDRED (\$4500) DOLLARS TO McKENNA-McALLISTER POST NO. 592, VETERANS OF FOREIGN WARS.

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

Section 1. The City of Providence is hereby authorized to contribute the sum of FORTY-FIVE HUNDRED (\$4500) DOLLARS to McKENNA-McALLISTER POST NO. 592, VETERANS OF FOREIGN WARS, a Veterans' organization duly chartered by the Congress of the United States of America, as a contribution to meet part of the cost of acquiring new building facilities for the use of said Post, such contribution to be upon such terms and conditions as the Mayor of said City may see fit to impose.

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect upon its passage.
