
RE: In reply to City Council Resolution that the Traffic Engineer is requested to relieve present "Parking Regulations" in front of 95 Hartford Avenue. Submitted by Councilman William J. Murphy.

Gentlemen:

The investigation of the area indicated that the parking in front of the Mercury Lounge is restricted during the time 4:00PM to 6:00PM. This restriction is necessitated by the turning movement from the D. J. Roberts Expressway, west bound on Hartford Avenue. Any vehicles parked at the curb in this area would be in a definitely hazardous position. Trailer trucks making this left turn from the D. J. Roberts Expressway are severely impeded by the parked vehicles. Therefore, it is our feeling that the 4:00PM to 6:00PM restriction in this area is necessary, and should remain in effect.

It should be noted that there is available parking on the southerly side of Hartford Avenue in close proximity to the Mercury Lounge.
