



6 be referred to as "The Garden of Heroes." This area shall be dedicated to any Rhode Island
7 resident who is a member of the Armed Forces of the United States, or any member of the Rhode
8 Island National Guard who is killed or who dies, whether it be through state or federal service,
9 while serving in the war against terror, or any United States military action since September 11,
10 2001.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
