Approved August 4, 1976

WHEREAS, in several past instances, upon the occasion of heavy rainfall, complaints have been made by residents along Iona Street, in the immediate vicinity of Admiral Street, the sanitary drainage facilities in the several homes have backed up, thus causing a health problem and in some instances, costly damage to private property of said residents, and

WHEREAS, the inconvenience and the cost of corrective repairs, are aggravating to the said residents,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Director of the Department of Public Works is requested to effect the correction of the sewer drainage problem in Iona Street, in the immediate vicinity of Admiral Street, to alleviate that problem.
